Examples of eligible Special Benefit (SB) or Status Resolution Support Services (SRSS) payment documentation

August 2021

Full names, addresses and Customer Reference Numbers (CRN) are redacted in these examples. **Do not** redact these details when you submit your documentation for a scholarship application, or it will be considered ineligible.

The most common reasons for documentation being marked as ineligible are:

- The scholarship applicant's full name is not visible
- Dates of the payment are not visible, or the last payment was greater than three months ago
- A screenshot of a bank account is provided instead of an official statement
- The type of payment is not visible
- The type of payment is not eligible*

Eligible benefits:

- Special Benefit (SB)
- Status Resolution Support Services (SRSS)

Eligible because:

- Official statement from Centrelink
- Type of payment visible
- Full name (redacted in this image) was visible
- Payment period was within three months of the time of application

*For this statement to be eligible, the scholarship application will have needed to be submitted **before** 5 January 2021, i.e. three months from the end of the payment period.*

For example, if you are applying for a scholarship on 30 August 2021, your statement must be dated anytime from 30 June 2021 to 30 August 2021. Providing a statement dated on or before 29 June 2021 would mean your evidence is not accepted.
